FIRST CALL

PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE

The thematic framework of the conference is defined by phenomena and issues related to the preservation of architectural heritage within the context of a green city economy. Architectural, especially urban heritage, is challenging to understand outside the broader context of the city, its landscape, green infrastructure, and sustainable development. The anthropological, social, technical, and technological context, as well as numerous other visible and less visible aspects of the urban landscape, shape the interactive relationship between architectural heritage and green infrastructure. In this regard, the challenges of heritage preservation, sustainability, and green cities present a platform for multidisciplinary research, examination, and discussion. The primary goal of the conference is to explore and examine new directions and possibilities in protecting architectural and urban heritage as an integral part of the urban landscape and the green city through a multidisciplinary approach.

ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION

The application must include: the title of the paper in Serbian (in Cyrillic/Latin script) and English, as well as the thematic unit, an abstract in Serbian (in Cyrillic/Latin script) and English – **up to 200 words**, the author's full name, institution/organization/company, contact details, and a short biography of **up to 150 words**. Participants intending to present their paper in person in English should submit the application and the paper in English only. After reviewing the submitted papers, authors will be notified if the abstract has been accepted and will receive detailed instructions for preparing and submitting the full paper.

REVIEWS AND PUBLICATIONS

All submitted papers will undergo a double-blind review process. Accepted papers will be published in the Proceedings with a unique ISBN and UDC number. Only selected papers will be presented in person as part of the conference program, while other papers may be presented as posters displayed at the conference.

PAPER SELECTION CRITERIA

The paper must correspond to the theme of the conference.

It must be original, not previously published or presented.

It should showcase new methods, findings, and experiences.

It should define key issues, questions, and provide answers

It must not offend the work and viewpoints of others.

It must follow the guidelines for writing the abstract and the paper itself.

The specified deadlines must be met.

There is no registration fee for the conference.

CONFERENCE FORMAT

The conference is to be held in the Cultural Heritage Preservation Institute of Belgrade. Single author can present a maximum of one paper at the conference.
